

Do you have to clean solar panels





Overview

Solar panels need to be cleaned to prevent dirt, dust, and other debris from accumulating on their surface and reducing their efficiency¹²³⁴⁵.

Accumulated debris blocks sunlight from reaching the solar cells, hindering the panels' ability to convert sunlight into electricity¹. Solar companies recommend cleaning solar panels at least twice a year, regardless of the weather conditions and where you live³. Regular cleaning can improve the efficiency and output of solar panels, extend their longevity, and prevent damage to the panels⁴. Do solar panels need cleaning?



There are some instances where solar panels might need cleaning, but most of the evidence says solar panels are self-sufficient and low-maintenance. We'll get to the best way to clean your solar panels in a minute.

How to clean a solar panel?

Many cleaning products are too abrasive for solar panels or may leave a residue that blocks sunlight, so you should choose these carefully. Try mixing a mild detergent in water, slowly adding more cleaner if you need more cleaning power. The last step in solar panel cleaning is to dry the glass and review your work.

Should you turn off solar panels before cleaning them?

Yes, turning off solar panels before cleaning them is essential to ensure safety and prevent electrical hazards. When exposed to sunlight, solar panels generate electricity, and even a small amount of residual current can pose a risk of electrocution. Turning off the system eliminates this potential danger, allowing for a safer cleaning process.

How often should a solar panel be cleaned?

Solar panels require very little maintenance, especially if they are on a tilt, as rain can wash away any debris. It is generally recommended that you perform solar panel cleaning between two and four times per year. Take extreme care when cleaning. Clean from the ground, as climbing around on your roof can be dangerous.
