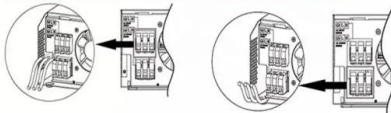


Parallel (Parallel operation up to 6 Unit (only with battery connected))

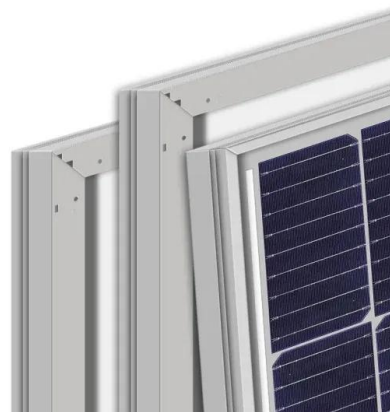
