Overview

The performance warranty insures you against your solar panels falling below their high standards when it comes to producing electricity. Your policy will usually guarantee you at least 90% production after 10 years, and 80% after 25 years. "The average degradation rate of solar panels still allows reasonable performance after 25 years."

How long does a solar panel warranty last?

The equipment warranty will cover you for physical failures, and generally lasts between 10 and 12 years. This will protect you against defects, the panels failing completely, and environmental issues causing a halt in energy production. Getting the warranty means that if your panels break, you won't suffer.

Are solar panel warranties transferable?

Most solar panel warranties are transferable, but check ahead of time to make sure the company you've chosen will allow you to pass on your warranty. If you can transfer the warranty, you'll be able to charge more for your property. After all, solar panels can save your home's new owners a lot of money.

Does project Solar have a lifetime warranty?

The average product warranty for a solar panel is 25 years, and some stretch to 40 – but Project Solar outdoes them all with a lifetime warranty for its Evo Super Max 455. That's the kind of confidence you want from a manufacturer.

Do solar panels outlive warranty?

Panels have a median degradation rate of 0.5% per year, according to a study by the US government-funded National Renewable Energy Laboratory. This



means your panels have a high likelihood of outliving their warranty – as long as you get high quality models.

How long do solar panels last?

Workmanship and materials warranty of one or two years. Batteries (non-grid systems / hybrids) roughly 5-15 years. Inverter (s) warranty of between 5-10 years. There are many factors that must be borne in mind when considering warranties for you solar panel system.

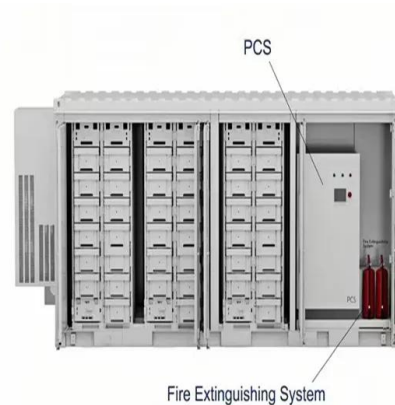

The average temperature coefficient for a solar panel is $-0.32\%/^{\circ}\text{C}$, which means for every degree above 25°C , a solar panel's output falls by a miniscule 0.32%

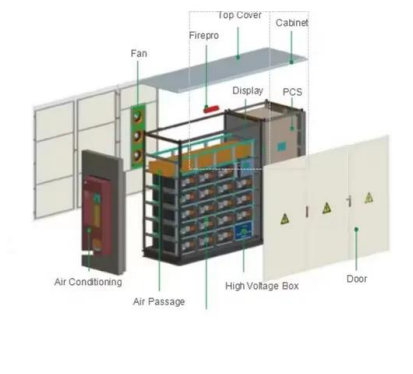
