

How to dispose of household batteries





Overview

How do you dispose of a battery?

To take advantage of this service, residents must simply tape up their batteries' exposed terminals (so they don't short-circuit and start a fire), seal them in a plastic bag, and set them on top of their recycling bin on their regular pickup day.

Where can I recycle a battery?

Bring the battery to a Collection Point for recycling. For operational considerations, the collection box may not be able to be placed in a prominent location of a Collection Point. Please approach the front-line staff or the manager of the respective Collection Point for details.

What happens when you recycle a battery?

When you recycle batteries, potentially toxic products are kept out of landfills. The batteries can be broken down into their components and the materials can be reused to make new products. The laws for recycling or disposing of batteries will vary depending on where you live.

How do you recycle a car battery?

To recycle a car battery, place it in a plastic bag to prevent any caustic materials from leaking before leaving it at the recycling drop-off point. The recycling facilities will sort the batteries properly.

Can batteries go in garbage or recycling bins?

Certain batteries should NOT go in household garbage or recycling bins. This page can inform you on how to manage these batteries safely. Waste batteries can always be recycled or taken to household hazardous waste collection points.

How do you use a battery recycling container?



It's easy to use—simply fill it with batteries and ship it to a recycling facility—and a pre-addressed shipping label, home pickup, and recycling fees are included in the cost of the container.

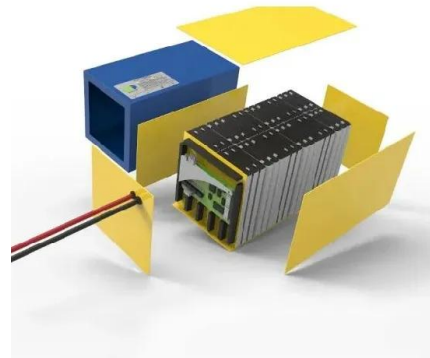

Alkaline batteries are everyday household batteries used in flashlights, remote controls, and other appliances, modern alkaline batteries contain little to no mercury. Most small, round, "button-cell" type batteries found in items such as watches and hearing aids contain mercury, silver, cadmium, lithium, or other heavy metals as their main component.
