Are crucian carp a good angling resource?

Carl has researched the decline of crucian habitat in his native Norfolk and is an acknowledged expert on the species. The NCCP was the brainchild of angling artist and crucian enthusiast Chris Turnbull who wrote the initial discussion paper ' The case for the conservation of the crucian carp as an angling resource.

Did crucian carp survive anoxia?

Crucian carp was the only fish in the pond that survived anoxia. Small lakes and ponds with winter anoxia result in dense populations of stunted and slender fish. In lakes with other fish species present, the crucians' numbers and densities are low and they grow to large sizes. In the presence of piscivores such as pike, crucians are deep bodied.

Is crucian carp a pond fish?

Conclusions. Crucian carp, *Carassius carassius* (L.), is a rather unknown fish that has received interest in science. Due to its hardiness, crucian carp has been used as pond fish and food source from the fifteenth century up to the late eighteenth century. There has always been a supply of fresh fish.

Are crucian carp invasive?

Crucian carp is also sensitive to competition and the closely related invasive gibel carp, *Carassius gibelio*, has become a threat to crucians. Gibel carp is not native to Europe, but has been introduced from Asia and used in aquaculture. Crucian carp has disappeared in locations where gibels are present.

Why is crucian carp important?

Crucian carp (*Carassius carassius* (L.)) is one of the species that, due to its unique physiological and behavioral adaptations, has received interest in



science. It has also become an important model species for laboratory studies of olfaction.

What are the main objectives of a Crucian pond conservation project?

The primary objectives are to:- The resulting benefits will include: improved understanding and protection of 'wild' or 'pure' crucian stocks; habitat restoration; creation of 'community waters'; more angling opportunities; increased resources for young anglers and better sharing of information on lake and pond conservation.

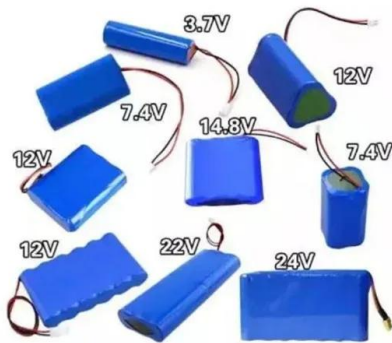

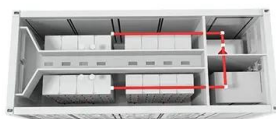
