Can solar panels be built without permission?

This is because they generally fall under permitted development rights, which allow homeowners to make reasonably sized changes without getting permission. The exceptions to this rule are typically flats, listed buildings, homes in conservation areas, and ground-mounted installations. What are the building regulations for solar panels?

Do you need planning permission to install solar panels?

Current rules that require businesses to apply for planning permission if solar panels will generate more than one megawatt of electricity will also be scrapped, meaning organisations will be able to install more solar panels on rooftops without the delay and cost of applying for planning permission.

Are solar panels legal?

However, it's crucial to understand that while installing solar panels is legal, certain conditions must be met. For most domestic properties, solar panel installations are considered a "permitted development" and do not require planning permission, provided they respect certain size criteria.

Do rooftop solar installations need planning permission?

Rooftop solar installations always need building regulations approval, but rarely require planning permission. This is because they generally fall under permitted development rights, which allow homeowners to make reasonably sized changes without getting permission.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system – so there's absolutely no benefit to



installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

Do solar panels come under 'permitted development'?

The key piece of legislation is The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (Amendment) (England) Order 2012. Our understanding of the legislation is that installing a solar PV panel system will now in most cases come under 'Permitted Development' if the installation is as below:
