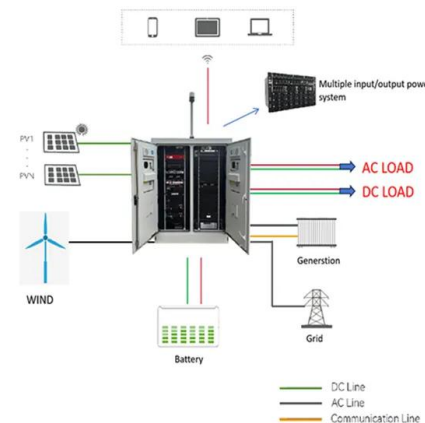

Understanding Your Bill

13. Excess Energy Credit (EEC) Compensation for the energy that you push back to the power grid. The amount is monetized based on your NMR-405 tranche, or tier (i.e. Tier 1 customers receive 95% of the retail rate). The EEC is calculated as $KWHA \times Tier$

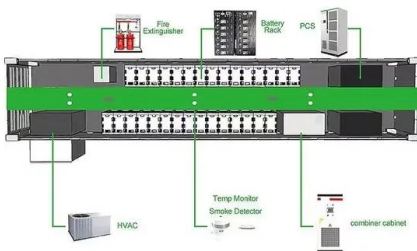

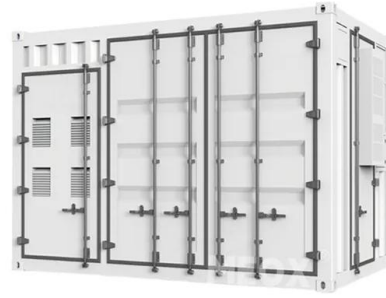
