What is a tactical microgrid?

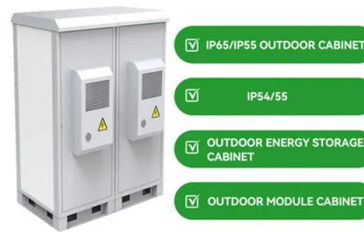

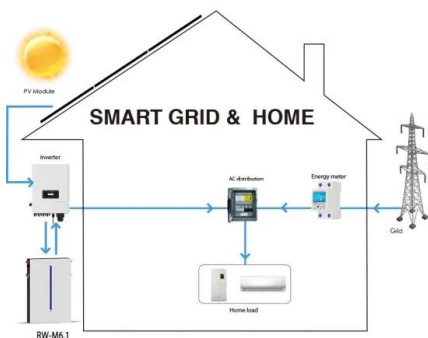
