Overview

Indication: Power Gear Logo is flashing Cause: Coach is already level Fix: Coach is already level. However, leveling.

Indication: Any two of the Up/Down/Left/Right lights (they could be flashing or ON solid or both) Cause: Coach is slightly out of Level Fix: This is normal anytime the coach is not already level. The arrows flashing o.

The Low Voltage light is flashing The voltage is low at the control Charge or replace the battery. If a leveling procedure is being attempted, the coach should be running to ensure a good voltage supply at the control.

Indication: Power Gear Logo is flashing Cause: Coach is already level Fix: Coach is already level. However, leveling can still be executed as normal (to stabilize the coach) .

Indication: The following lights are flashing together: Wait and On/Off Cause: Transmission is in gear OR improper wiring of the neutral safety.

Indication: Any two of the Up/Down/Left/Right lights (they could be flashing or ON solid or both) Cause: Coach is slightly out of.

Indication: Park Brake light is flashing Cause: Park brake is not engaged OR improper wiring of the parking brake wire Fix: Engage park brake. If that does not work, check the wiring of.

Indication: All lights are flashing together (no buzzer) Cause: Unit is brand new OR user put system into this mode. Unit is waiting for a programmed level position Fix: See Tip Sheet #153 on how to set a new level position. How do I troubleshoot a power gear leveling system?



If the issue persists, consult a professional for further assistance. Troubleshooting a Power Gear leveling system may involve checking for correct calibration and proper mounting, testing for voltage drop, and inspecting electrical components. Additionally, disconnecting wire harnesses and checking hydraulic fluid levels can be helpful.

What is a power gear leveling system?

The Power Gear Leveling System is a hydraulic system designed to automatically level and stabilize recreational vehicles (RVs) to ensure a comfortable experience for the occupants.

Why is my power gear leveling system blinking?

If you notice the low-voltage LED blinking on your power gear leveling system, it suggests a problem with the system's power supply. Here's an overview of the possible blink patterns and their meanings: Rapid Blinking: The voltage is critically low. Check the power source and ensure proper voltage.

Why is the power gear logo flashing?

The Power Gear logo is also flashing. Cause: This is a self diagnostic check and is normal anytime the ignition is turned on. Fix: The control will turn back off after the check is complete, or another error code will flash Indication: Power Gear Logo is flashing Cause: Coach is already level Fix: Coach is already level.

How do I know if my power gear is flashing?

For example, if On/Off & Wait & the Power Gear Logo are all flashing, there are 2 modes at the same time (Already Level mode and Transmission mode) For approx 5 seconds. The Up, Right, Down & Left lights flash in a clockwise pattern. The Power Gear logo is also flashing.

Do all power gear leveling systems have manual override valves?

Not all Power Gear leveling system pumps have manual override valves. Power units for double acting systems that have manual override valves have flexible rubber caps on the valves and a hex override nut under the button cap on the electric motor.

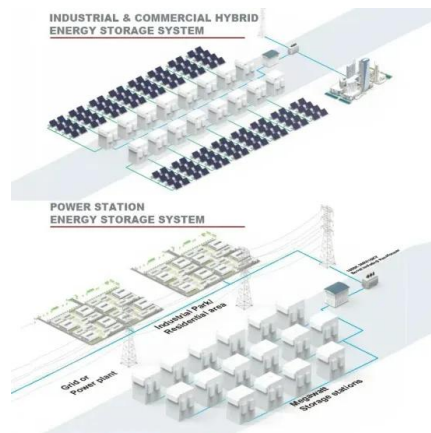

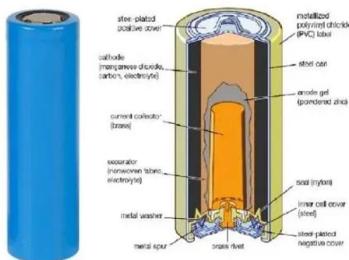
