Can solar panels be installed on a flat roof?

How to install solar panels on a roof?

Take into account the roof orientation of the panels and ensure that the mounting framework is slightly tilted, usually between 18 and 36 degrees. Some companies use solar trackers to improve the efficiency of energy conversion. Following the mounting setup, the solar panels are securely attached to the mounting structure.

How much do solar panels weigh on a flat roof?

Crucially, solar panels on a flat roof need a heavy ballasted mounting system to stay secure at the correct angle in high winds. However, a typical ballasted solar panel setup can weigh around 100kg per panel, compared to only around 20kg per panel for a non-ballasted system.
