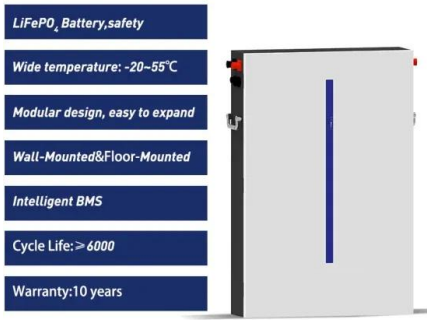
What Does Hours of Protection mean on the Generator?
