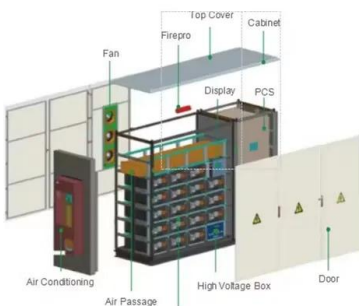

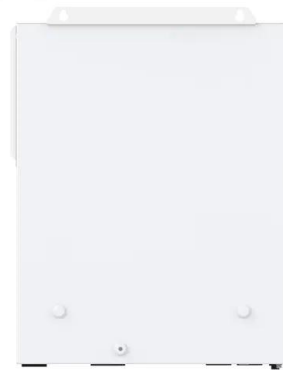
Nonrenewable Energy
